ELIGIBILITY/DEADLINE

- Deadline to apply: Monday, February 28, 2022
- Offered to students residing in the Venice, Nokomis or Osprey Area and/or a Venice graduating senior as of Spring, 2022.
- Pass/Fail Criteria - Must maintain a 3.0 or higher grade point average

HOW AWARDED/AMOUNT

- Amount depends on funds raised – will award more than one if funds permit
- Must submit 3 letters of reference – Minimum of 1 letter from school
- Must submit weighted grade point average verification (copy of most recent report card, unofficial transcript or other proof) (GPA may be confirmed by Committee)
- Application rated on: Need and Merit - Leadership Qualities, Goals, High School Activities, Community Involvement, Work Experience, Exceptional Achievement, and GPA.
